Trinity Catholic College Auburn Campus is one of eleven sites that make up Aspect South East Sydney School. Our school is part of Autism Spectrum Australia (Aspect) and as such is covered by all Aspect's policies and procedures.

There is one class at Trinity Catholic College Regents Park. This caters for students requiring a stage 4 (Years 7 and 8) life skills based program.

There is also one class located at Trinity Catholic College Auburn catering for students requiring a stage 5 (Years 9 and 10) life skills based program.

Official school hours are 8.35am to 3.13pm. Students can arrive in the morning from 8.30am. Aspect students will be dismissed at 3.00 pm. Aspect staff meet students on Kingsland Road between 8:30 and 8:40. Our students will be dismissed at 2:45 Monday – Wednesday and Friday and at 2:20 on Thursday which is sport day on Kingsland Road.

In the event of wet weather students will remain inside their classroom. Morning tea is between 10.40am-11.05am and lunch from 1.40pm-2.10pm. Thursday break times will differ slightly. Students are supervised at all times during breaks.
